Goals for 2014

Priority 1 Mission and Religious Education

Policies, programmes and practices which explicitly articulate the nature and purpose of Catholic schooling, within the broader evangelising mission of the Church.

- Implementation of the new Religious Education Curriculum P-7.
- Continue to implement recommendations from the Enhancing Catholic School Identity Project.
- Build on current practice to formalise individual and whole school prayer culture.

Priority 2 Learning and Teaching

Enhanced Pedagogical Practices that are data-informed and evidence-based.

- Use of BCE Business Intelligence Tool to record data and use for data analysis with staff.
- Integrate data analysis into curriculum planning cycle.
- Continued participation in the Visible Learning Program.
- Staff participation in Reading to Learn professional development and program implementation.

Priority 3 Professional Practice and Collaborative Relationships

Partnerships that provide for consultation and engagement with parents as the primary educators of their children in the mission of the Catholic school.

- Informing clergy and parents about the Religious Education curriculum.
- Encourage increased parent participation in school life and students' learning.
- Continued participation in Kids Matter framework, working with parents and carers.

Priority 4 Strategic Resourcing

Contemporary learning approaches inform the planning, design and use of facilities.

- Continued implementation of Visible Learning pedagogy.
- Purchase of contemporary classroom furniture to compliment current approaches to classroom design.
- Co-ordinated management of technology.
