The agenda is:-


- 9am** Whole School Mass – Celebrating Mercy Day

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
Religious Education and Religious Life of the School

Judaism in the Religion Curriculum


St Francis Xavier last week welcomed Professor Peta Goldberg who led a professional learning opportunity for teachers about 'understanding Judaism to understand Jesus'.

Teaching and learning about Judaism is in the religion curriculum for students in Brisbane Catholic Education schools in every year level. In exploring and investigating the mission and ministry of Jesus, it is critical for our students to be able to recognise that Jesus was born, lived and died a faithful Jew and understand what this means.

Dr Ari Lander from the Sydney Jewish Museum describes the relationship of Christianity and Judaism as "like siblings" with both religions developing in dialogue with each other. He comments on how we share the stories of the Hebrew scriptures but clarifies that each religion, from the time of Jesus, has continued to evolve into distinct living traditions – each with its own rituals, prayers and practices.




Our staff found the session highly valuable and are looking forward to sharing insights with their classes.

 - Be eligible for the Medicare Child Dental Benefits Schedule; or,
 - Hold, or be listed as a dependent on, a valid Centrelink concession card.

It is a requirement for QLD Oral Health to Bulk Bill all CDBS eligible clients. Opting to use your CDBS funds within our service will ensure **NO FEES OR OUT OF POCKET EXPENSES** even if your benefit cap has been reached. If you choose not to use your CDBS funds with our service you have the option of attending a private dentist.

PARENTING RESILIENT KIDS



We are inviting parents and their primary-school aged children to take part in a new online parenting program designed to provide parents with strategies to parent with confidence and stay connected with their pre-teen child.

WHAT IS THE RESEARCH ABOUT?

You are invited to participate in research being conducted by Monash University, led by Dr Marie Yap. The research aims to evaluate whether our new online parenting program can help empower parents and in turn build their child's resilience.

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

You will be randomly allocated to one of two groups, to receive either:

1) An individually-tailored, interactive online parenting program that will give you practical strategies you can use to parent your child more confidently;

OR

2) An information package of 8 weekly factsheets about child development and well-being.

· We will give you a 5-minute call once a week until you have completed your allocated program.

· We will ask both you and your child (if they agree to take part) to complete some online surveys at the beginning, and after 3 and 12 months.

In total, participation in this research will take a few hours of yours and your child's time over 12 months. To say thank you, you will be reimbursed with e-gift vouchers.

All components of the online program can be done using a computer, tablet, or smartphone.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Parents or guardians of a child aged 8-11 who live in Australia, are fluent in English and have internet access.

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St Francis Xavier Kindergarten

We are a stand-alone kindergarten located next to the Outside School Hours Care building and Parish office. We are a not for profit service managed by Centacare Childcare Services and operated by two staff, the Teacher/ Director (Bachelor Qualified) and the Teaching Assistant (Diploma Qualified).

There are two classes which both operate on a 5 day fortnight (Kindy A- Mon/Tues& alternate Weds) & (Kindy B- Alternate Weds & Thurs/ Fri). Contact the Director on (07) 3381 8872.



The Kindergarten program operates during school terms for children who are at least 4 years of age by 30 June in the year they participate. Families may be eligible for support to reduce out of pocket expenses or rebates and financial assistance such as QKFS Kindy Support to help cover the cost of fees.

At kindergarten your child will be:

- engaging in an approved Kindergarten program delivered by a qualified teacher to support learning as children transition to school
- learning about themselves others and their surroundings
- building partnerships with local schools to support children as they enter prep
- building relationships with children, families and the wider community
- engaging and participating in meaningful and quality play based teaching and learning experiences
- developing independence, thinking and problem-solving skills
- building self-confidence and resilience
- building a better understanding of the world around them.
